



## Pastor's Corner

Dear Church,

This month I want to talk about prayer. If I were to ask our members about what prayer is, I imagine I would get answers like "it is talking with God" or "communicating with God," and these answers are correct. In fact, those are ways that I have described prayer. However, those descriptions leave out a key component of prayer. That component is dependance. In my personal life, I have found that the most powerful prayers, the ones where God answers in a visible way, are the ones that I come before God and say, "I don't know what to do." I have had my share of prayers where I talk to God about the burdens of my heart. I have had prayers where I complain, and I have had prayers where I ask for things from the Lord. I do not believe these are wrong. Communicating with God, no matter what we are feeling, is vital to growing in Him. Too often, however, I have seen myself praying these things without a dependence on God. I respond to the things that are happening and then convey them to God with emotion. What might be better is to go to God with an open heart, whether we are responding to something that has happened or praying about what might come next, and recognize that we cannot shape it and we need him desperately. I believe the disciples learned this lesson when they tried to heal the demon possessed boy in Mark 9. They had cast out demons before. They had healed in the name of Jesus as well. Yet, this time they had no power. Jesus told them that this demon would only come out by prayer. I don't believe Jesus meant that this demon was more powerful or that a special prayer would have worked. Rather, Jesus was reminding them of their need for dependence on God. When we fail to pray with dependence, we begin to think that we have things figured out and we can handle them. The reality is that our scope of control is much smaller than we often think. So, this month as you pray, I hope that you will come before God with a heart of dependence.


