Deep Dish Pizza Casserole

12 Servings (3x3 inch square) 170 Calories each serving

Ingredients

- 1 pound lean ground beef
- 15 oz can tomato sauce (no salt added)
- Cooking Spray
- 10 oz refrigerated pizza crust
- 1 cup reduced fat mozzarella cheese shredded
- 1 cup fresh baby spinach
- 1 yellow bell pepper sliced
- 1/2 cup cherry tomatoes halved

Directions

- * Pre-heat oven to 425 degrees F
- * Brown lean ground beef in a pan over medium heat
- * Add tomato sauce to cooked, browned meat. Cook together and let simmer
- * Spray 9x13 in baking dish with cooking spray
- * Unroll refrigerated package of pizza crust, pat well & smooth out up to the sides
- * Sprinkle 1/2 of the cheese on the crust & cover with all of the meat sauce.
- * Top with spinach, bell pepper, & tomatoes
- * Bake in oven for 12 minutes.
- * Remove from oven, top with remainder of cheese and return to the oven until melted.

Pastor's Corner

I recently read an article where a person admitted that they have "people-like-me syndrome." This highlights the reality that we are often drawn to people like us and repulsed, annoyed, or angry at those who are different from us. This is a natural human response that we must be aware of and we must fight against. Maybe you are a quiet person and loud or boisterous people annoy you. Maybe political differences cause division in your life. Maybe there are underlying presuppositions or racism that you have not dealt with. Whatever the case, it is likely that you too suffer from "people-like-me syndrome." So, how do we move away from such actions? In Luke chapter 10, Jesus responded to a man in the bible who suffered from such a syndrome. He was trying to justify his picking and choosing of who he displayed love to as he asked the question, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus responded by telling the parable of the good Samaritan. This is more than the story of a man showing kindness to a stranger on the side of the road. It is a challenge to this man, and to all of us, to push cultural and racial boundaries. It is a call to show love to every human we meet. This story would have shocked the man and all who were listening. The Samaritan was the hero! It is the call to examine our inward biases and challenge them. Jesus does this by showing the humanity behind the stereotype. When Jesus highlighted the Samaritan's acts of kindness, he became more than just one of "those" people. He was now a person who showed kindness to another human. We must be willing to see the humanity of those who are different from us. Sometimes this means extending conversation even when it is awkward and tense. In those conversations, recognize the tension and even state it out loud if necessary. Pay attention to your anger and frustration and hold off responding until you have listened more. Sometimes this may mean being curious. Questions can bridge gaps in relationships. They can help us to understand, even if we do not agree. This month, think about the people in your life. Are they all like you? Are there people that you struggle to see as a neighbor? Are there people that you struggle to love? You do not have to like every person you meet, but you are called to love everyone, and this begins with seeing their humanity.
