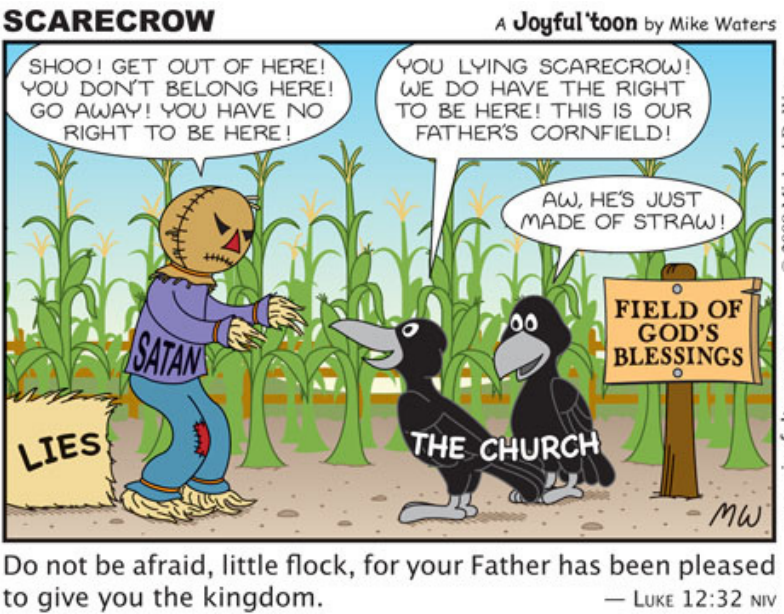

Ingredients
Dressing
¼ cup - olive oil
¼ cup each - dice red onion & cilantro chopped
¼ cup - white wine vinegar
¼ teaspoon each - black pepper & smoked paprika
Salad
4 cups - corn off the cob or defrosted frozen corn
1 cup - cherry tomatoes sliced
1 - green bell pepper diced
zest of lemon (about 3 Tablespoons)
½ - avocado diced
⅓ cup - diced green onion
Directions
*Combine all dressing ingredients into bowl and mix.
*Set aside.
*In a large bowl, combine all other salad ingredients
*Pour mixed dressing over other salad ingredients and mix well
*Serve immediately.

Recently, one of our church members attended the ICare conference that South Texas Children's Home (STCH) puts together. This conference is for people who help others from counselors, to teachers, to pastors and caretakers. One of the main takeaways that she brought back to me was the idea of the 1 degree shift in building intentional connections. This makes me think of the words that Paul shares from Romans 12:18 "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone." The context for this verse is forgiveness and love for those who have mistreated you, however, I do think it is applicable in almost all our relationships. It reminds us that we have a responsibility to build and repair relationships. It also reminds us that there are elements of our relationships that we cannot control. So, essentially we build where we can, and let go of the rest. The idea of the 1 degree shift helps us to do this in a very practical way. The 1 degree shift is a small change that we can actually follow through with. It is something that is specific and measurable. It is something that is focused on our own behavior, not on others or things that we cannot control. And finally, it is something that is repeatable in everyday interactions.
