### Pastor's Corner

Dear Church Family,

As we have been going through the book of Mark in our Sunday morning series, we have seen a strong emphasis on Jesus' compassion. He had compassion for the crowds who hungered for real answers, for the people that came to him hurting and in need of healing, and for those who suffered at the torment of demons. Jesus looked at them and loved them. We also see his compassion for his disciples who followed, but often didn't get it. They knew he was special and worth leaving things behind for, but they failed to see him for who he truly was throughout most of his time on this earth. Yet, he was patient with them. He loved them. He walked with them through it all. In Colossians 3:12 Paul calls us to clothe ourselves with (or put on) compassion along with kindness, gentleness, humility, and patience. When we put on these attributes, we become like Christ. This isn't a task for some of God's people. It is not just for those who naturally are more meek in nature, rather, it is a call for all of God's people. Often, we do pretty good at showing compassion to those who love us back. Yet Jesus showed compassion to everyone around him. Both those who loved him back and those who turned their backs to him. We must show compassion to the lost in our community. As Jesus looked out at the crowds, he saw them as sheep without a shepherd, lost and helpless on their own. Then he went among them, taking care of needs and pointing them to the gospel. This is compassion. This is what we are called to do. My challenge for you this month is to be a people of compassion. Look for new ways to show compassion to the people in your neighborhoods and community. Show compassion to your fellow brothers and sisters in church as well as the potential brother and sisters that you meet as you go about your week. Let's be a church with open arms and open hearts!
