Pastor's Corner
Dear Church,

Wow, it is hard to believe that the year is almost over and that the Christmas season is already upon us. The holiday season often means time with family and friends. It is also a very busy season for many people. It is easy to become absorbed in all the places to go, people to see, gifts to get, and meals to prepare and we often miss opportunities to share Jesus with others. This holiday season, take some time to remember that we are called to a ministry of grace and love to all. In Luke 10:25-37 Jesus tells the parable of the good Samaritan. Many of you are familiar with this story. We remember it as the story of a man who showed compassion on another and took care of him when no one else would. While this is true, it is not the main point of the story. The story is an answer to a question that was asked of Jesus. A lawyer had asked Jesus who was considered his neighbor and the story answers that question by pointing to the fact that your neighbor may not be the person you expect. Jesus then challenges the man to go and do as the Samaritan did. That would come as a shock. He wasn't to be like the priest or the Levite, men to whom he would have looked up to, but like the man that he would have never even gone near. Boy, was his world shook up that day. If we are going to display Christ in our daily lives, we must be prepared to show love, mercy, and grace to everyone, and particularly to those who do not expect it. This Christmas season, show love to the "Samaritans" in your life. The people who feel that they are excluded from God's love for one reason or another. Take some time to show them that they truly are not excluded, but they are loved by God and by you just as they are. When you do this, you will be displaying fruitfulness on the frontlines of your life, not just on Sunday.
