I 15.25 oz box of flavored cake mix (Strawberry is good!)

8 oz thawed cool whip Powdered sugar

Directions



Dear Church,

My sermon series for all of December has been "Down to Earth" as we talk about how our savior came down to meet us and how He challenges us to move forward. This year, I want to challenge you to have a down-to-earth attitude like our savior. Take some time to consider how you can meet others where they are at. I think of Jesus' encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well in John 4. She was just an ordinary person that he encountered in an ordinary place. Yet his love and care for her, and his unlikely invitation made the encounter anything but ordinary. She was changed forever. She couldn't wait to tell others about her experience. 





Bible Study & Discipleship Classes

There are two opportunities to study the Bible weekly. Every Sunday morning at 9:30, we have Bible study for all ages. Wednesdays, there is a meal at 6:00 and Bible study at 6:30. If you would like to help offset the cost of the food for the church, there is a donation jar in the fellowship hall.

Our men's and women's discipleship classes will start meeting again this month. There will be a breakfast Saturday, January II at 9:00 for both groups to kick-off the new year. Starting the next week, women will meet at the church on Wednesdays at I:30 p.m. Men will meet on Thursdays at 9:00 a.m. Everyone is welcome to join us.

Building Recap

The expansion project work has begun! This is an exciting time in the life of our church.

We are grateful to be able to fully fund this project with monies we already have. We were able to replenish our vision fund with over \$1100 thanks to the tamale fund raiser. Money in the vision fund will be used to replenish the building fund and help with expenses after the project is finished.

CHURCH NEWS

On Sunday, December 15th there was a called business meeting immediately following the morning service. This meeting was called to vote on the church's 2025 yearly budget. The motion was made by the council. By show of hands, the members voted to accept the 2025 budget unanimously. There was no discussion.

We collected food goods to make 9 baskets to give a some church and community members for the holiday season.

Serving Hands

We have a designated fund called Serving Hands. The money in it is used only for church and community members who find themselves in a time of need. We started the year with a balance of \$1,357. This year we have had \$2,118 given in donations and tamale money. We spent \$2,829. We helped a total of 13 people (6 church members and 7 community members) 29 times this year. We try to limit the help to \$50-\$100 a time. Sometimes it ends up being more. Sometimes less. But this fund provides help when people really need it. Some people just needed some gas to make it to a doctor appointment in Houston. Some needed help with a hotel room for the night during cold weather. Others just needed some food. A few people were short a little bit on their electricity or water bill. We don't help with rent. Currently, the balance for the Serving Hands fund is \$646. Our goal this year is every month at least 10 church members donate at least \$5.00 each to this fund. This is a way to help others in times of need anonymously. It's easy to give. You can write "Serving Hands" on your giving envelope. You can write it in the memo of your check. We also have a link in our online giving through our website you can use. There is a reminder card included in the newsletter and some by the church doors. You choose a month or two in which you want to give and put the card on your fridge as a reminder!
