Pastor's Corner

Dear Church Family,

While summer time is often busy for most people, church life tends to slow down. Though our church calendar may not be filled for this month, it is a time of planning and digging in. I find myself asking, how are we fulfilling our vision as a church and how can we do that better with future events and services? How are we building and training disciples? My challenge for you is to do the same with your life and time. Take some time to reflect and dig in. Assess where you are with God. How are you fulfilling His calling in your life? How are you building relationships that point you and others to God?

One of my favorite hymns is "Come Thou Fount." In that song there is a line that says "here I raise my Ebenezer, hither by thy help I've come." This is a reference to 1 Samuel 7. This section of Samuel is chaotic. The ark of God (which represented His presence among His people) had been taken by the Philistines, yet God showed His power and forced them to send it back to Israel. Some of the Israelites did not respect God's commands regarding His ark and they died. This catches their attention and then it says that the people "mourned and sought after God" as the ark sat under guard for 20 years. It is during this time that Samuel calls the people to step back and reflect and dig in. They leave their idols behind and they gather to seek after God's will. As they are doing this, the Philistines gather to attack them. They become afraid, but rather than run or panic, they turn to God and seek His help. He confuses the attacking Philistines and stops their attack. Then Samuel sets up a stone to commemorate all that God had done to bring them through. That stone was called Ebenezer.

Sometimes we need an Ebenezer stone to remind us that God is working through all the chaos. When life is not fair, when we are unfaithful and disobedient, God is still working. When we repent He is faithful to forgive us. When we step back and seek after Him, He is faithful to carry us through the dark moments. So this month, take some time to dig in and reflect on all that God has done and how you can seek Him moving forward. Let's move forward stronger as a church, seeking God and loving others.
