Pastor's Corner

Dear Church,

Hebrews 11 is known as the faith chapter in the Bible. In this chapter, we find a long list of people throughout the scriptures who displayed faith in amazing ways. There is much to learn from this chapter. I would like to focus on the last two verses of this chapter. It is interesting. The writer does not end it with a description of how each of them reaped the reward of their faith. Instead, we see that they did not receive what they were promised. They did not see the salvation of God. They did not see the nations coming together in worship of him while on this earth. They did not see peace and the victory of God. Instead, the last phrase is "they would not be made perfect without us." This points to our connectedness. Our faith is not so that we can be something great on our own, rather, it is part of God's big picture which displays all believers as better together. Think about this for a moment. We are connected through faith with all who have lived and will live in relationship with God. Beyond that, we are part of a faith picture, a masterpiece, that we all partake in. That is how the writer can go on to say "Therefore, since we have such a large cloud of witnesses...let us run with endurance the race that lies before us." We can have strength to persevere because we are not alone. We are part of the bigger picture that God, the master artist, is painting. This is a great encouragement to us as well as a challenge to see everyone around you as an important part of your faith. You need them and they need you. Your story is not complete without them, so cherish them, build them up, love them, and encourage them. This month, take some time to read Hebrews 11 and ponder the significance of our connected faith.


