Pastor's Corner

Dear Church,

It has now been several weeks since our churches started meeting together as a merged congregation. I had one member share with me that they felt a buzz of excitement in our new congregation. This really is an exciting thing to be a part of as we create something new. We have started putting in place the people, structures, and processes necessary so that our church can begin functioning as a single unit. It is taking some time, but it will enable us to efficiently do ministry as we move forward. As we begin transitioning into more ministry and outreach, I would like to encourage each of you to think of yourselves as missionaries. As we continue to focus on our commission in Matthew 28:19-20. Jesus re-emphasizes this call in Acts 1:7 as he reminds his disciples that they will be witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. The call is both across the street and across the world. First this reminds us that every conversation that we have is an opportunity to point someone closer to Jesus. Evangelism is not reserved for specific, church-wide events. It is something that we all participate in everyday as we are at work, at school, in the grocery store, or even at the doctor's office. Look for opportunities for gospel conversations. Secondly, if we view ourselves as missionaries, then we learn to be curious.
