

It is hard to believe that February has already come to a close. At this point, I am


Pastor's Corner

Dear Church,

feeling the weight of many of the prayer needs within our church. There are many that we need to care for and commit to prayer. While we must not neglect our ministry to each other, we also have a call to minister to the lost world around us. This month I want to focus on our need to do more than just model our faith before others. Over the past few months, I have shared practical ways that you can live as followers of Jesus outside the church walls. Many of these ways do not involve speaking. We have seen that we can display God to others when we model Godly character, when we work for God in all circumstances, when we care for others with grace and love, when we recognize our position as children of God, and when we stand up for truth and justice. This month, I want to remind you that we also have a call to proclaim the gospel to the people around us with words. This call is not replaced by the actions listed above. It works in conjunction with them. Peter reminds us of this call in 1 Peter 3:15-16. In the middle of a conversation about suffering and persecution, he reminds his readers to always be ready to give the reason for the hope that they have. There are some serious expectations in these verses. First, there is the expectation that we are going to have people in our lives who question the hope that we have. There will be people who do not understand and even those who may try to stop you from seeking after Jesus. Secondly, there is the expectation that we will be living in such a way that they not only notice our hope and faith, but they see it as significant enough to question us about it. This is a challenge. It means that we are going to be uncomfortable and the people around us are going to be uncomfortable, but it is not until that point comes that we will have a true opportunity to share the hope that we have. It is the hope of the gospel that drives us to respond in a Christlike way when life is unfair. It is what drives us to love in the midst of hate, praise God in the midst of suffering, and seek God in the midst of chaos. This month, take some time to think about how you will respond when people question the hope that you have. Do not be afraid to be around people who will question it, those who don't know the peace, love, and joy that Christ brings. Ask the Father to help you trust the Holy Spirit to give you the appropriate words and timing when sharing this hope.




