Pastor's Corner

Hey United family,

The past few months I have been sharing with you ways that you can live out the gospel life on the days you are not at church. This month I want to highlight work. **How can we share the gospel with others through work?** Everyone of us works. Whether we are getting paid for a job or we are serving our families or volunteering our time, we all engage with work. It is important for us to remember that work is designed by God as a blessing for humanity. It is not punishment. Genesis 1 and 2 give us a basis for this understanding. First of all we see God working. He is modeling this for us as he is creating. Secondly, in Genesis 1:26 we see that work is tied to the blessing of being an image bearer of God. We work just as he does. The call to rule the created things of the earth was not one of harsh rulership, but one that reflects God's rule of mercy, love and kindness. When we work (when we create, when we serve, when we help, when we care for, when we fix, when we clean, when we teach, when we tear down and rebuild, etc...) we are displaying God to the world. Though we can often feel stuck in our jobs, these verses remind us that we have work for a reason. The curse of sin has often made work hard and unfair.

Colossians 3:22-24 acknowledges this as Paul gives instructions to Christians who were facing slavery. Though their situation was unfair and they were mistreated, they were still called to work, not for the sake of their masters, but for the glory of God. Though work has been corrupted by sin and we have to deal with, and work to correct the effects of this brokenness, work in itself is still God ordained and important to Him. When we work with intentionality knowing that it is for the glory of God and we combine that with the godly character that I talked about last month, we can be a gospel witness to those around us. So this thanksgiving, as you are thanking God for all the blessings that he has given you, take some time to thank him for the work that you have been given and the witness that you bring to others when you engage with it.

### **FINANCE COMMITTEE**



Agape Service Thanksgiving Meal




On Saturday, November 18, we will have our Agape Service as
