



#### Pastor's Corner

Dear Church Family,

It has been busy around the church in the last month. Between the welcome bags for UHV, preparations for the meal for the teachers, and collecting items for their teachers' lounge, we have been busy planning and preparing. With all these events and opportunities we have, we must be careful not to lose sight of God's work in the ordinary parts of our lives. I recently watched a video from a ministry that emphasized "frontline" Christianity. The idea is that God is working just as much in our ordinary days as he is in the extraordinary times. We often forget that God is working in our hearts and lives in everyday experiences. We can think back to moments where we felt the presence of God. Maybe it was a church service or revival meeting and we just knew that we were right where God wanted us. Or maybe we can think back to a moment where we were able to meet a need or minister to someone in a special way. We knew that God was working in that moment. Yet, if I were to ask you what Jesus has done in your life this week, could you answer that? The reality is that God is working in your life each day. He is placing you in places where you can grow and where you can minister to others, but we often don't see it in the ordinary. In Colossians 1:15-20 Paul reminds the Colossian believers that Jesus is supreme over all things. He is in all things, before all things, and in Him all things hold together. Take a moment to reflect on this. Jesus does not just show up in the big moments. He does not just care about the highlights of your life. He is shaping you and the people around you as you work, go to the grocery store, spend time with your family, or go to school.

This month I pray that you would take some time to step back and see what God is doing in the ordinary days of your week. Then share it with someone. Tell them a story of how God shaped you in an ordinary day. Let others know how you were able to minister to someone's need in a small way, how you were able to model Godly character, how you were able to shape the culture around you, or how you have shared God's love with someone in your life. Let's be "frontline Christians" every day, not just on Sundays.
